



## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM SUMMARY AND GUIDELINES

The Downriver CU Scholarship Program provides a select group of graduating seniors with a one-time, non-renewable scholarship of **\$1,000.00**. Funds can be used for tuition, room & board, meals, or books. Scholarship applications should include all required documentation and **submitted no later than Friday, May 5, 2023**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by Friday, May 26, 2023.

### **Eligibility**

- ◆ Must be a graduating high school senior.
- ◆ A member in good standing of Downriver CU – *must have joined on or before December 31 of the year prior to the awarding of the scholarship.*
- ◆ Have a minimum GPA of 2.50.
- ◆ Must be accepted for enrollment in a college or trade school.
- ◆ Demonstrated leadership ability and community involvement.

### **To Apply**

- ◆ Write an **original 500-word essay** on the following topic:  

***“What are your career aspirations and how do they relate to the credit union’s mission of helping people ‘accomplish great things’?”***

PLEASE NOTE: Essays must be typed, double-spaced, 12-point font, and no longer than 2 pages. Avoid the inclusion of any names so that we can ensure unbiased judging of the essay. Content, grammar, punctuation, and spelling will all be taken into consideration.

- ◆ Include the following documentation to complete your application package:
  1. **Cover Letter** (*not required if using online application form*)
  2. **Scholarship Application** detailing organizations, clubs, organized sports, or other accomplishments, that helped you to develop qualities of a leader.
  3. **High School Transcript.**
  4. **Letter of acceptance from a college or trade school.**
  5. **2 Letters of Recommendation** from a non-family member at your church, school, employer, or community organization.
- ◆ Submit your Scholarship Application and upload the required documents using the link on our website at [www.downrivercu.com/scholarships](http://www.downrivercu.com/scholarships) (click on Resources, then Scholarships) by **Friday, May 5, 2023** to be considered for this scholarship. Applications may also be mailed to the address on the Cover Letter.
